The project will employ living shoreline techniques that utilize natural and/or artificial bre shorelines along an area in Portersville Bay in the Mississippi Sound near Point aux Pins project will create breakwaters to dampen wave energy and reduce shoreline erosion whincreasing benthic secondary productivity. Over time, the breakwaters are expected to penthic secondary productivity, including, but not limited to, bivalve mollusks, annelid w forage fishes.
