Recent Update:

In 2023, construction of the project was completed.

Project Modifications:

Originally, it was anticipated that this project would create up to 624 acres of marsh near Bayou Grande Cheniere, approxi ridge along Jefferson Canal, and approximately 48,900 linear feet of earthen containment dike.
