**Description:**

The Marsh Island (Portersville Bay) Restoration Project involves the creation of salt marsh owned island in the Portersville Bay portion of Mississippi Sound, Alabama. This project of salt marsh through the placement of a permeable segmented breakwater, the placement of native marsh vegetation. Additionally, the breakwater will provide protection for the island which has been experiencing shoreline loss.

Recent Update:

In 2023, the 5th year of monitoring is complete. The State will seek additional construction on the northwest corner of the island.

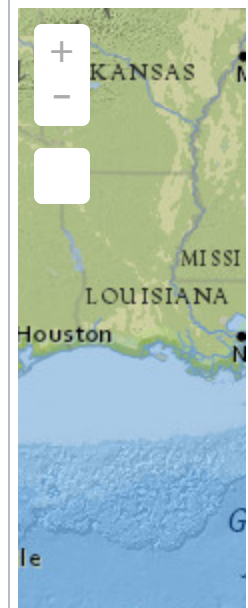
