#### **Description:**

This project improved access for the public seeking to access the beach and water of S pavilion/parking lot areas. The improvements included construction of two new beach a pavilion/parking lot areas to the Santa Rosa Sound. Additionally, a new kayak/canoe lau constructed to increase opportunities/access for recreational boating in the waters of th roughly 1-acre area of degraded dune habitat to enhance the recreational experience by natural state. This restoration involved planting gaps in the existing dune within the projection.
